1.1.1. - In Progress	<p><b>Support design standards and policies that aim to preserve or enhance neighborhood character.</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• NCDOT requested photos of past and/or present homes in the Burton Street Community to serve as architectural style examples that could be used the development of the pattern book.</li><li>• The BSCA will contact residents to request copies of their neighborhood photos, and review other resources including the 2016 NCDOT Burton Street Architectural Resources Survey Report.</li></ul>
1.2.1. - In Progress	<p><b>Improve existing sidewalks to meet ADA design standards.</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• NCDOT and the City of Asheville will coordinate regarding funding for correcting the incompliant ADA pedestrian accommodations on sidewalks within the neighborhood.</li><li>• The remaining City budget will be discussed in September and priority locations should be identified to be included as a part of the record for future projects.</li></ul>

<b>2.2.1. - In Progress</b>	<b>Improve community center with more parking, a computer lab, Wi-Fi, and community meeting spaces. Improve the basketball courts and playground.</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Asheville Parks and Recreation presented a sketch of the Burton Street Community Center and surrounding areas and discussed potential locations for additional parking. It was noted, the playground could be relocated to the lower area along Bryant Street to allow for sufficient parking expansion as well as ADA accessibility.</li></ul>
